Restart of production at Wonawinta Site

Manuka Resources Limited ("**Manuka**" or the "**Company**") advises that it has recommenced production at its Wonawinta site after being hit by a severe, localised weather event on Saturday.

The Company originally expected the plant to be down for around four to five days, however the plant resumed normal operation on Wednesday having completed a 24-hour restart period post the temporary shutdown to effect interim repairs from the weekend storm damage.

The Company's Operations Manager, David Power said: "The team on site worked extremely hard to make the plant safe and carry out temporary repairs to get the site back into an operational condition with a successful restart earlier than predicted. The health and safety of our personnel was imperative after the event. Their commitment to ensure the plant was operational in the shortest time possible was exceptional."

The Company is working closely with its insurance broker and is focused on ensuring remaining repairs are completed in a timely manner and without further disruption to production.
